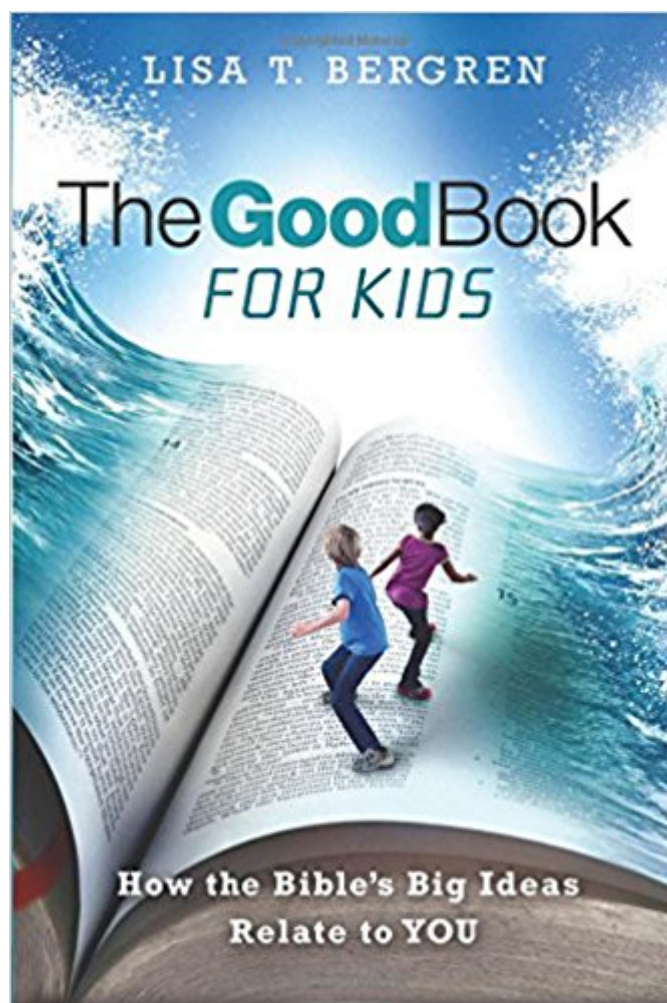

Lisa T. Bergren is the award-winning author of over 40 books, with more than 3 million copies sold. Her books include the young adult series Remnants, a devotional called [Upside-Down Prayers for Parents](#), and [The Busy Mom's Devotional](#), as well as the bestselling picture book series God Gave Us You. Lisa and her husband, Tim, have three children. They live in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Inspired by Deron Spoo's book "The Good Book", Lisa Bergren has written "The Good Book for Kids", which is developed to specifically help kids understand the principles of Christianity and God's love. Some of the thoughts and commentaries in this book come directly from Spoo's book, and many of the ideas are similar but presented in a way that kids can more easily understand. The book itself is more of a narrative of the key stories of the Bible. It is written in a way that seeks to engage young readers and instill Christian principles in them whether they realize it or not. This is followed by a section that presents the "skinny" (or key points) of the scripture store, and then a

section designed to tie the Bible story to the child's life and allow them to reflect on what they have learned. Some parents may not like the format of this book, or the fact that it is more of a storybook than a Bible study for kids. However, the complete passages of Scripture from each chapter are presented at the end of the book. Your kids can reference the actual Scriptures at any time. I would suggest reading Deron Spoo's book at the same time that your child reads this one so that you can have an engaging family discussion about the key stories of the Bible. I received this as a free ARC from David C. Cook Publishing on NetGalley in exchange for an honest review.

My daughters and I read this book together this summer, and each one of us was sad when we got to the end. It is a wonderful way to share basic Biblical stories & truths with kids, in a fun and exciting way. Each chapter has a Bible chapter to read, then a brief explanation of it, along with a retelling, either a modern day story, or some other style, followed by questions and explanations to really explain and discuss about what was just read. It is directed at kids ages 9 - 15, in our home, even my 8 year old daughter loved it! I was thrilled to see this book getting my daughters excited about learning more about the Bible! I received a copy of this book in exchange for an honest review.

It was okay. The stories to help the kids understand were good, but it did not cover a lot of the major stories that most kids learn. Therefore, we would use it and then have to wait a while before the next one to stay in sync with our Sunday school class.

This is an absolutely fantastic way to get your kids into the Bible. We read something every morning at the breakfast table and I was so excited to come across this book! The stories really put you in the Bible world and explain things that may not be clear when reading directly from the text. I wish there were 20 more books like this one for my kiddos!

I am a nine year old girl, just FYI. I enjoy how it is kind of like you are in the book. It's like you're a part of the story, watching it. There is a lot of imagining, like the Bible story is really happening. It's like the author, Mrs. Bergren, is talking with you. I also like the really soft book cover. It is very comfortable to hold.

Wonderful book! We are gonna love its reading!

I have two 10 yr olds and It's perfect for them!! I love how she brings the Bible to life by taking you

back in time!! My 3 yr even enjoyed parts of it even though she didn't understand it all :) The questions are thought provoking and good for parents to discuss with the kids.
