

Not for NC fishermen. He really doesn't give the detail I expected for the North Fork or especially

the South Fork of the New River. Most North Carolina kayak fishermen fish the South Fork of the New, which joins the North Fork only a few miles before the VA border, and this area gets very skimpy coverage in the book. I expected more since it had the NC part in the title.FWIW... I expect information about portages, slopes of put in/take outs, distance between bridges/landmarks to last or next take out (to measure my journey). I can find spots to fish on my own.

Bruce is a great guy and a hell of a fisherman. Anyone wanting to learn more about the New River will want to buy this book.

It gives great descriptions of the river sections and the fishing involved. I have done several of the floats so fare and find the authors insights and descriptions to be spot on. If your going to fish the New River for the first time buy this book.

This is a good guide, but the author is too cautious about every aspect of the outdoors. Most things that are enjoyable or are worth doing include some element of risk. Knocking back a few beers while you're canoeing, jumping off rocks into the river, pushing the upper limits of your paddling ability, etc. are what makes life enjoyable. If you are going to be a worry wort, just sit on your couch.

He lists a whole bunch of lures, tells you to fish deep ledges, then most of the book is river guidebook which can be obtained from a reputable river guidebook, or even better, from the Internet.
