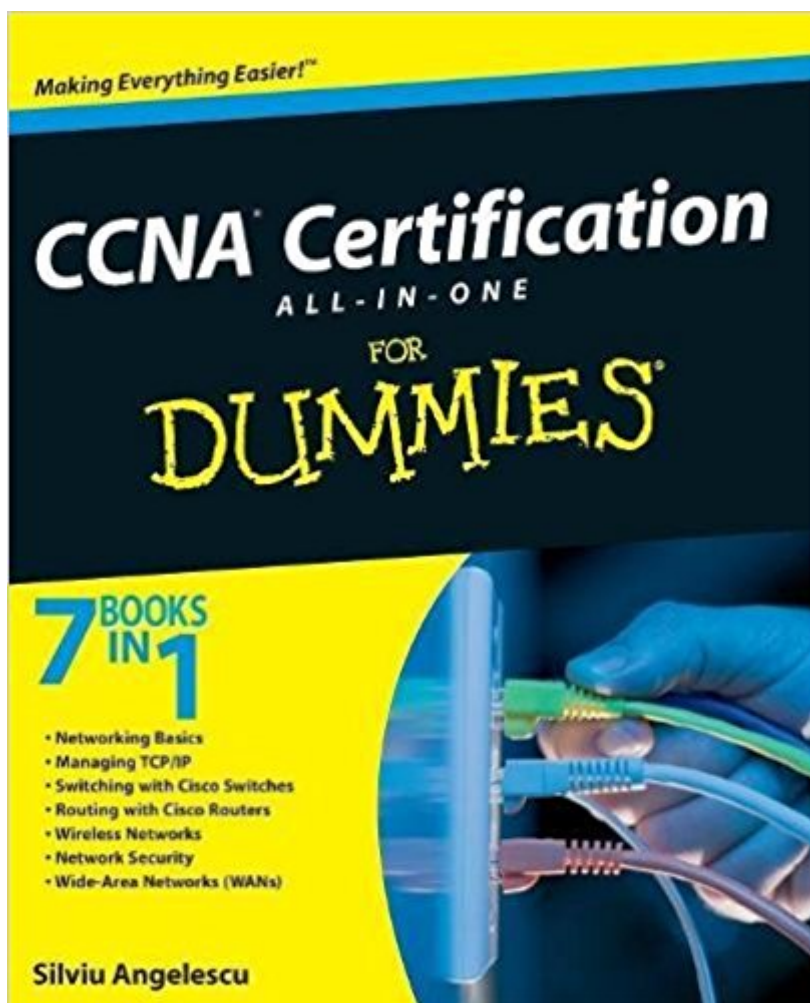

I took a CCNA course but needed a better explanation of certain parts of the CCNA and this book put things into perspective. If you find CCNA books too technical....try this one first.
