

For those of you thinking about this book (if youâ Â<sup>TM</sup>re not why are you reading this) please review the comments and take them as the validation of the material in the book that they are.To the 1-Star Trolls: I know this book triggers you but please stop, you look like a bunch of kindergartners being beaten up by a professional football player.

The author lays out not only the inconvenient, uncomfortable truths that the Left wants to wish away, but WHY the left (and voters who lack discernment) ignore and deny these truths. In Part I, we read the words of one left-wing operative (R. Creamer), "When presented with facts that are inconsistent with the frame through which people view the world, the frame will generally win, and inconsistent facts will be discarded or discounted. Thatâ Â<sup>™</sup>s why our top priority has to be the relentless repetition of our frame." The Left knows that people get stressed over evidence that what we believed to be true is not (you'll see much demonstration of this stress in the emotional reviews of this book). Not only that, we often accept a belief because it makes us feel better about ourselves to identify with the ideas of the Left, even if they're nonsensical, false, ineffective or damaging, and for that reason, we don't look closely enough to see that they are. This book is divided into three parts: "Suppressing Dissent," Suppressing Debate," and "Suppressing Truth." In each of these parts, there are 6-7 chapters dealing with specific topics that liberal message-makers seek to control using the toolbox methods of personal attacks (those who disagree are stupid or evil), straw-man arguments, name-calling, intolerance, exaggeration, rationalization, and lies. The book is rife with examples on a variety of issues, including radical Islamic terrorism, gun rights, minimum wage, climate change, Amereican exceptionalism, Christianity, poverty, race, immigration, and more. This book is very timely as the Democrats -- who have blocked nearly every legislation opposing slavery, segregation and Jim Crow -- attempt to convince unthinking Americans that they're the party that champions minorities, and as their presidential candidate condemns Trump for inciting fear about a real threat (Islamic terrorism), as her party incites even more fear over climate change computer models. This book demonstrates why, as parents, we need to teach our children to be rational, to know why they believe what they believe, and to value clarity over feeling good. As Americans, we need to understand the issues rather than swooning over slogans, to seek answers, not validation. This book can help sort out the uncomfortable facts, see how lofty-sounding ideas play out in real life,

and understand the dangerous thinking behind the relentlessly repeated phrases and emotional appeals.
