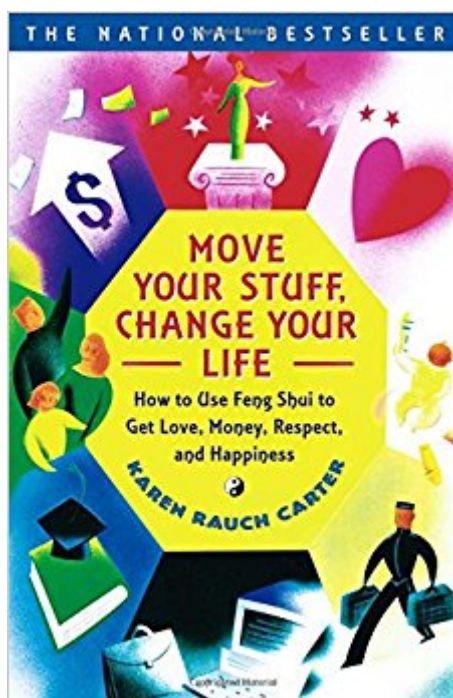

She points out the reasonableness of Feng Shui, which is not always explained well in other sources.
