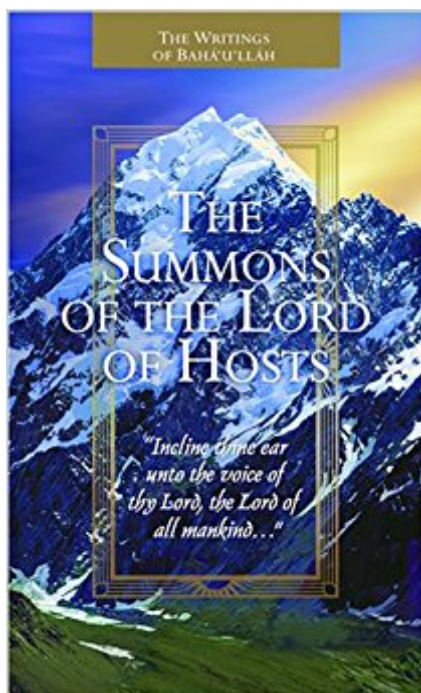

Baha'u'llah, a title of honor meaning "The Glory of God," is associated with Mirza Husayn-'Ali (1817-1892), the Prophet and Founder of the Baha'i Faith. Baha'u'llah claimed that His Divine Mission is to bring about the spiritual rebirth and the unity of mankind. His voluminous writings, collectively referred to as The Revelation of Baha'u'llah, are the foundation of the Baha'i Faith, the world's youngest independent world religion.

This Book contains several of His Holiness Baha'u'llah's greatest and most challenging Writings addressed to the chiefs and leaders of the world, as well as to ministers and others holding offices of authority in the realm of international affairs. It sets out what is nothing less than the "new heaven and new earth," the "new Jerusalem" as promised to mankind from God's Messengers of old. It is "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth, as it is in heaven." The promise of all religions, the dawn of the Day of God when all mankind will be gathered together, has come upon us while we

were unaware. But now, everyone knows and understands that we all are neighbors whether desired or not.
