

"Alcorn has been narrating his own books for some time now, for better or worse. His untrained style is never better utilized than here. In this work about the concept of heaven (an adaptation of his work HEAVEN, for adults) he keeps his manner conversational, as if talking directly to children. Kids introduce the questions, and Alcorn responds. He sounds practiced as well as comfortable with his own vocal limitations. He speaks kids' language, interjecting words like "cool" and "awesome" where he feels necessary. This adaptation is also aimed at adults looking for ways to answer their

Great book! This is a clear, easy to read book that will answer any questions your child or you might have about Heaven! It is the "easy" read version of Alcorn's "Heaven". Both books are excellent and based solely on Scripture as opposed to some of the other books out right now that claim to have inside information.(near death experiences). The book is for kids (and adults) 10 and up, I'd say, younger if a parent reads it to the child. It is upbeat, funny at times and incredibly hopeful. I have given it to kids that have lost loved ones. One thing to be sensitive to: if a Christian child has lost a loved one who wasn't a believer, give the child a little time to mourn before reading this book. Alcorn does say that only God knows a person's heart, and that people can come to Him through their final breath, still it's best to be very sensitive to a child's feelings about the subject. That said, Alcorn paints a Scripturally sound picture of Heaven which had been a comfort to me and many I know on many occasions.

I read this before giving it to my teenage grandchild after the death of her dad. A lot of Biblical research obviously occured before the author wrote this very informative book. It will be particularly meaningful for any child/teen who is familiar with C.S. Lewis' The Chronicles of Narnia books as the author uses many passages from those books to help illustrate scriptures. Externely well done and would definitely recommend it. (I've read the "adult version" of Randy Alcorn's book Heaven and actually enjoyed the "kids version" more!)

My family has been studying both the original "Heaven" and "Heaven For Kids" since our littlest died in February. Knowing the truth and joys of Heaven and the New Earth which are waiting for those who profess Christ, is the BIGGEST source of comfort for me as a bereaved mother. I also now understand the importance of building Heaven in our children's minds as we learn to serve Christ with our lives. If we don't know what we are working for, then how can we give our entire being to the Lord in service and love? This is the BEST book for learning about Heaven and creating an excellent stage from which to imagine the beauty of eternity with the Lord.

It helped open the door to conversation about where Grandpa is...in heaven. The book is an easy read written in teenage language and in a question answer format. This sons and wives really appreciate my giving them the books. I put the adult version on my Kindle. I'd recommend these books to everyone because we're going to spend a whole lot more time in heaven than here. It's very realistic and has been a great comfort to me as I learn more about heaven.
