

Much like the real-life Dr. Laura Schlessinger, Dr. Susan Chandler, the star of You Belong to Me, is a clinical psychologist who hosts a call-in radio show. She's bright, sharp-tongued, and even has "shoulder-length dark blonde hair." Fortunately for Dr. Laura, the similarities end there. During an episode of Ask Dr. Susan, Chandler unwittingly gets herself tangled in the web of a dangerous serial killer. It begins innocently enough when Chandler invites Dr. Donald Richards, a criminologist/psychiatrist/author to talk about his book, Vanishing Women and the plight of lonely women who are preyed upon by calculating killers. Chandler is particularly interested in the disappearance of woman named Regina Clausen, a high-profile investment advisor who vanished on a luxury cruise. Chandler feels indebted to Clausen--an investing tip she offered on CNBC turned a modest birthday check into a "bonanza"--so the good doctor uses her radio forum to help crack the case. Sure enough, during the last moments of the show, a nervous, married woman who goes by the name "Karen" calls in with invaluable clues. Apparently, she was almost a victim and can identify the murderer, but is frightened to come forward because of an insanely jealous husband. As Dr. Susan pursues her timid witness and digs deeper into the case, she realizes a hair too late that she is also one of the hunted. I found this book quite chilling in parts, but then it is a mystery/thriller. Women are going on cruises and disappearing when they go ashore, each a different port. There were three men who could have been the killer and MHC wrote the book to point to each one. So who was it? I couldn't make up my mind, until not far off the end when something happened that pointed directly to the killer. I have many of MHC's books, and I read them again and again. This one will be no different, and at some stage I will go back to read it again. It is a classic MHC and I have no problem recommending it.

I really like this author, for although her books are considered to be romantic thrillers, there is never an "obligatory love scene". This book is no exception. Filled with suspense is my honest opinion. As the characters were slowly developed, I found myself settling on THE suspect, only to decide it was the wrong one. After about 3/4 of the way I just KNEW that I had figured it out. And THEN the plot unfolded and I was quite surprised. Anyone who seriously likes Mrs. Higgins' books will want to read this one for sure!! would have given this one 5 stars, for IMHO, it was that good. However, I was using the Kindle version and for some strange reason, this one did NOT have the "X-ray" function. Thus this rating is more about the lack of what I SHOULD have had rather than the book itself! Otherwise, it is 5 star in my opinion.

This was a great book! Dr. Susan Chandler finds herself in the midst of a murder mystery when she invites an author to be interviewed on her daily radio show. Soon potential witnesses are being

killed and the closer Susan comes to putting the final peices of the puzzle together, the more her life becomes endangered.I didn't know until the end the book who the real murderer was. Every time I thought I had it figured out, something would happen to point the finger at someone else. There are also intersting sub-plots involving Susan's family and their problems regarding the recent divorce of her parents and an old rivalry between Susan and her sister, Dee.I have read many of Mary Higgins Clark's books. You Belong To Me may not be her best work but it was definitely very good.
