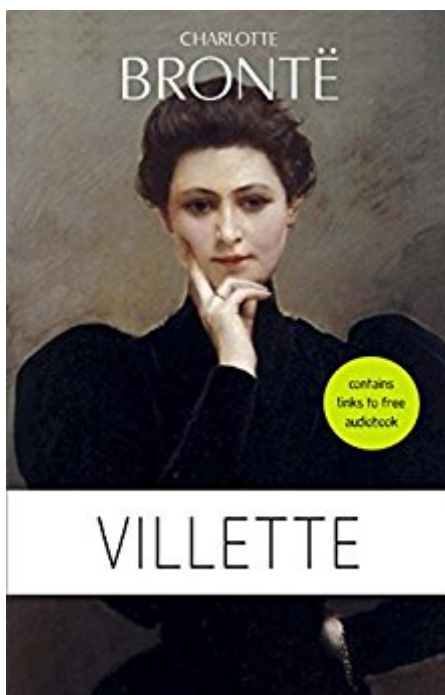

magazine, and is printed with very small text. The standard printing of this novel is just over 500 pages, but this edition is only 207 pages, managed by the minuscule text and massive page size. The outside is aesthetically pleasing but this edition is not meant to be read.
