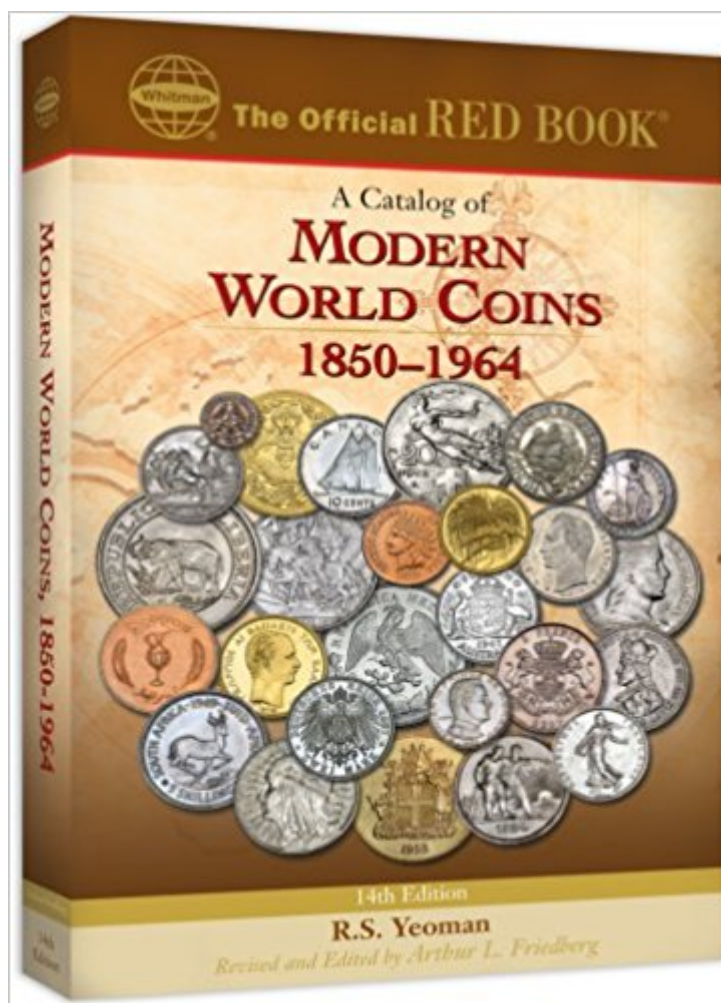

Hard to understand at first but finding the coins in the book got easier.

Note that this book does not include German states types from 1850-1870, even though the discription claims to have "all countries". In addition, it does not have information by year, or information about metal content (other than basic type). I plan on returning this item.End story: This may be barely usable for a beginner or to get a basic idea regarding world coins, but you are way better off buying a different world coin guide, even if it costs more.
