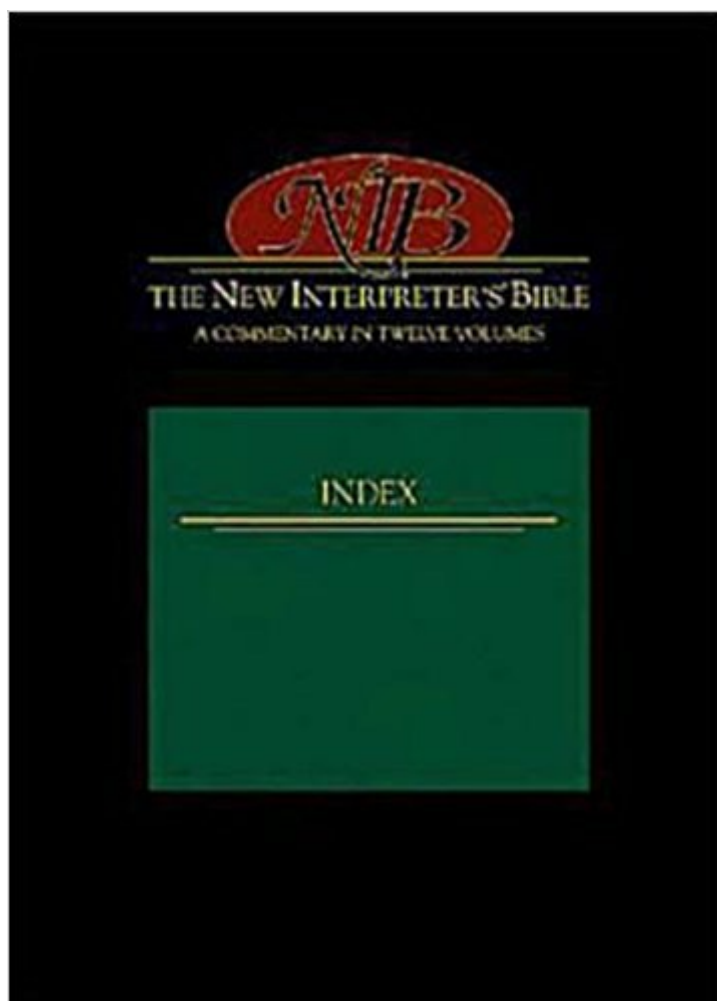

Synopsis

The New Interpreter's Bible Index (NIB Index) is the definitive reference guide to the major subjects, names, and places discussed in the New Interpreter's Bible: A Commentary in Twelve Volumes (NIB). The NIB Index continues the NIB tradition of providing the best in contemporary biblical scholarship for the service of the church, through the enhancement of preaching, teaching, and the study of the Scriptures. The design of the NIB Index, like that of the NIB, was shaped by two controlling principles: (1) form serves function, and (2) maximum ease of use. The NIB Index allows fast and easy access to all twelve volumes of the NIB, resulting in optimum use of the commentary. Now the reader can search for and find references to and in-depth discussions on a wide variety of topics, including the NIB's visual aids as well as its text. Focusing on those entries that address a topic substantially and advance discussion significantly for the reader's needs produced the following indexes: Subjects and Themes Ancient Literature Persons in the Bible Persons Outside the Bible Places in the Bible Places Outside the Bible Biblical Languages: Hebrew and Greek Lists of Maps, Charts, Illustrations, and Abbreviations Excursuses (further expositions of biblical topics) Reference Lists from the Bible (for example, prayers in the Bible and names of women in the Bible). Arrangement of the indexed terms is appropriate for students, teachers, and preachers of the Scriptures. For example: Main Headings that are relevant to the interests of the reader Cross-References to guide the reader to related areas of interest Format that is easy to read with clear, large type Accuracy in page references Scope that encompasses from names, places, and themes, to Greek and Hebrew words with their translations.~

The New Interpreter's Bible series is outstanding. I am a full-time minister, and I would rate this the number one commentary series available. The index is a very useful component of this series.

I am a seminary student who drives down to the school library to use these books for every paper I write. Though they are costly, it's cheaper than the gas cost added up. A must for any student.

The New Interpreter's Bible is a twelve-volume series, updating the popular Interpreter's Bible from a few decades ago. There are several key features common to all of the volumes of this series. First, each includes a two-column, double translation of the Biblical text (NIV - New International Version, and NRSV - New Revised Standard Version) arranged by topical unit or story. Then, they provide commentaries that look at the passages as a whole, as well as verse-by-verse. Third, interesting Reflection pieces that relate the passages to each other, to history, and to current concerns occur at the conclusion of each passage. Fourth, introductory articles for each book are provided that discuss transmission, historical background, cultural setting, literary concerns, and current scholarship. Finally, there are general articles about the Bible, each Testament, and various types of literature (Narrative, Gospel, Wisdom Literature, etc.) are provided to give general placement and knowledge about the text overall. The list of contributors, editors, and consultants on the project is a veritable Who's Who of biblical and theological scholarship, representing all major traditions and schools of thought liberal and conservative. Leander Keck, of the Yale Divinity School, is the primary editor of the series. The volumes were published individually, and can be purchased individually, which is a good thing, given that they are a bit expensive. But for any serious biblical scholar, preacher, student, or enthusiast, they are invaluable. High praise goes to the general editorial staff for working with such strong authors/scholars, that their work fits together well

as part of this set while retaining their individual characteristics (much like the writers of the Bible itself!). This is an index volume for the twelve-volume set; as such, it is helpful but not absolutely necessary for the user to use the set.
