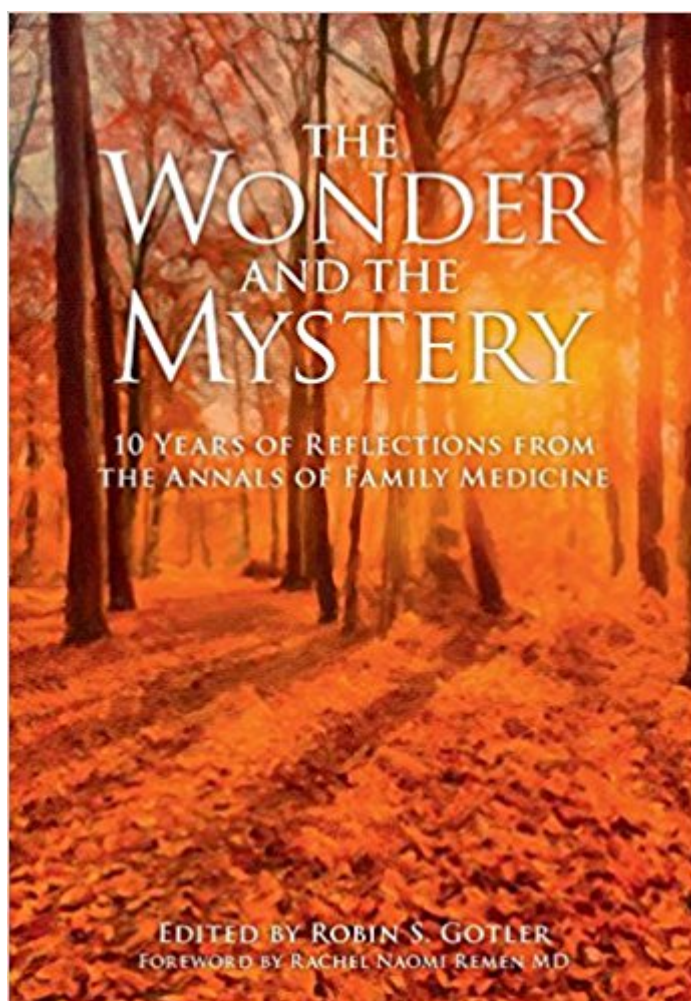

Some I had read years before but were new all over again. Most, if not all, of the authors are primary care clinicians and researchers telling the stories of their day-to-day clinical care. The writers pause to be with their patients in the daily struggles; they offer healing, they accept healing. The journey takes us along the path of pain and dying, and what comes after a patient, or loved one, dies. The Wonder and the Mystery offers the full journey along life's path. And it provides a full measure of insight into the human experience of life and illness, living large, and dying well. It is a worthy read and wonderful addition to my library.
