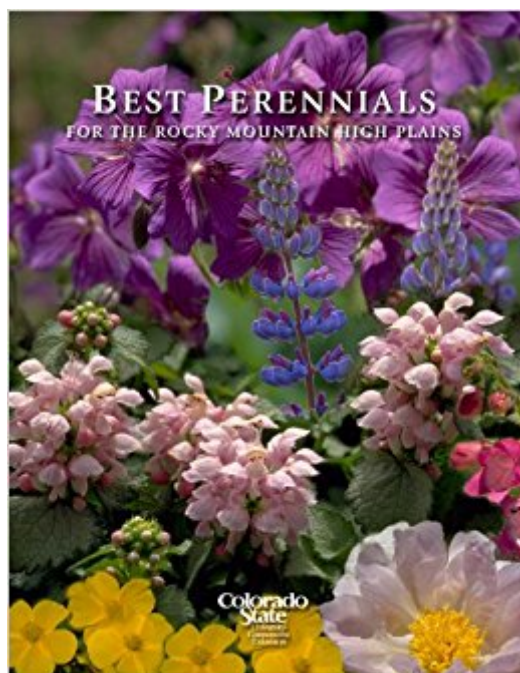

I bought four books to study and to get some ideas for reviving our old yard. You win some and you lose some. The plants in this book are in order by their Latin names. There is a common name index in the back, but you have to already know what you are looking for in order to use it. The book has some beautiful color photos, but not everything is photographed. There are tables in the back of the book showing average blooming times of the plants, by months and days. This would probably be a

very useful book for a landscaper or other professional. For me, it just didn't work.

Enjoyed this book as it will help with future buying of plants for my garden.

This is a publication of Colorado State University that describes the top perennials grown and evaluated in the Fort Collins research gardens. Each plant is listed by botanical name, variety name, and a brief description of cultural requirements. In the back is a chart listing bloom times for each plant by color (orange, red, blue, etc) which I found to quite valuable in choosing among the best perennials.

This book looks like they printed it at their local office supply store and there are any surprises here. I love a good gardening book with beautiful, crisp, photos and I love to learn something that's not easy to find on the Internet.
