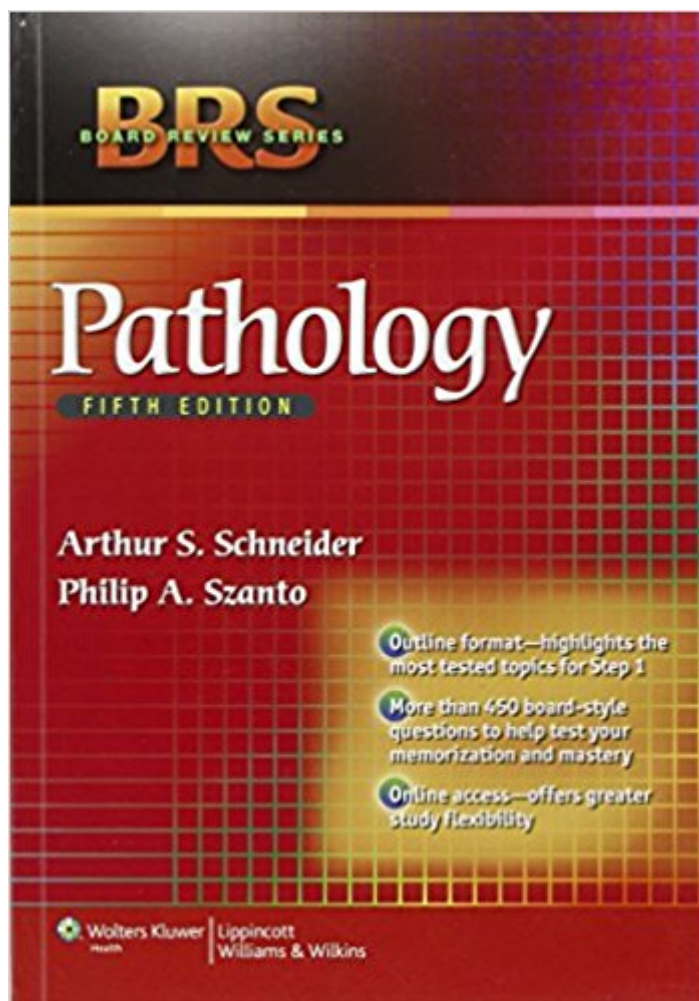

BRS Pathology is a pretty good book. There is a total of 24 chapters including a chapter on interpretation of diagnostic lab tests. Each chapter begins with a short reading that is organized very well with major headers. The separation of subheaders/topics is also visually very clean. Key topics are notated with an orange key icon. The book is soft cover but the paper is thick and of high quality. There are numerous images of patients, H&E (or other special stains) microphotographs, gross images, and tables/charts throughout each chapter. The questions at the end of each chapter are well written and contain good hints that guide you to the correct answer. Each answer at the end of the chapter is clearly explained why it is or is not the correct answer, and it also provides a brief explanation on why the other answers were incorrect. All in all, this is a good book to have around.

This book is a lifesaver when you don't have time to read Robbins Pathology before a test. It highlights most of the subject areas and gives you the general points, whereas Robbins can get lost in the details. Beware though, sometimes entire subjects are skipped in this book from the newest edition of Robbins, so don't be surprised if you don't remember reading something in BRS and it was asked on a test.

This wasn't a required text for my pathophysiology class, but it has proven useful in studying for exams in that class. It is much clearer and more concise than the two required texts.
