

Moranâ ™s flailing, retro-pop cartoon characters are the lure to this fizzy but enlightening entry in the Community Helpers series. A class taking a field trip to a construction site meets mustached Mr. Moore, who expounds upon the basics. (In a nicely realistic touch, â œHe says we have to stay outside the fence.â •) Mr. Moore shows off the various machines and techniques that will help build this future school, taking special care to talk about safety measures (hard hats, vests, beeping trucks) and green energy. The text, delivered in a wacky font, offers easy-to-digest nuggets (â œSome trucks work with big metal teethâ •), while boxed sections explain the scene more deeply (â œAn excavator digs wide ditches for basementsâ •). Zany to look at but pretty darn educational. Grades 1-3. --Daniel Kraus
