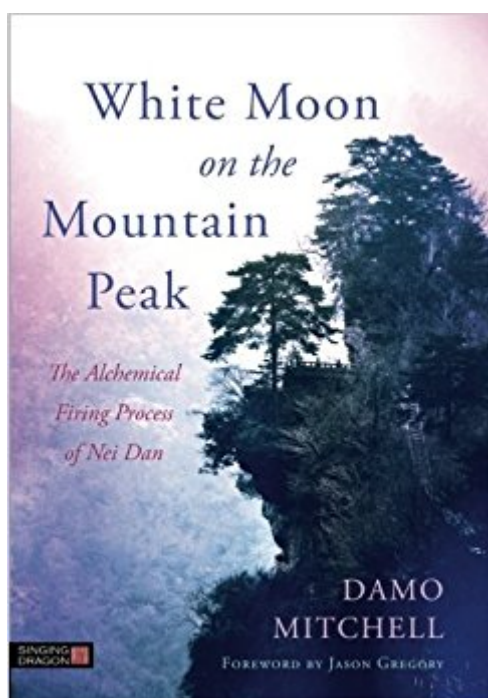

Prior to encountering Damo Mitchell, the books I had come across on the internal arts came in two varieties: they were either easily comprehensible but lacked the depth and substance a practitioner needed, or they were poorly translated versions of highly technical esoteric texts.
