

This is not from the website but helps clarify that the "Book of Pastoral Rule" by Gregory the Great is the same as "Pastoral Care" by Gregory the Great. About the different titles: "Since its first translation into English in the ninth century we have continued to call this book 'Pastoral Care,' a title which is most probably derived from its opening words: Pastoralis curae ... But the author, Gregory the Great, ... refers to it as 'Liber Regulae Pastoralis,' the 'Book of Pastoral Rule'" (page 3 of the introduction of the Henry Davis translation).
