

This book is great for people like me who know zero about music but want to teach themselves to play the dulcimer. It starts with the basics (parts of instrument, how to hold & strum) and includes many songs that I'm familiar with from my childhood. With self-discipline to practice, this book will help anyone to become a decent player.

I bought this book and haven't figured out how it's the best method book yet. It uses a different tuning than the other books I have, which use DAdd. I tried retuning and the chords and notes don't sound right.

Good beginners book with some good info. There are a lot of beginner songs to learn, mostly older traditional style songs but they do sound great on the dulcimer.

I was looking for Tablature but this is single note music. A bit too simplistic for me. I ended up just using it for a few pages in the front and then got most of what I was looking for online.

The book is very good. It is the one my dulcimer group is using to learn more. It is nice to have the fret marks over the notes since some of our group don't read music. The number so songs will give a lot of practice with different types of music. It is working really well.
