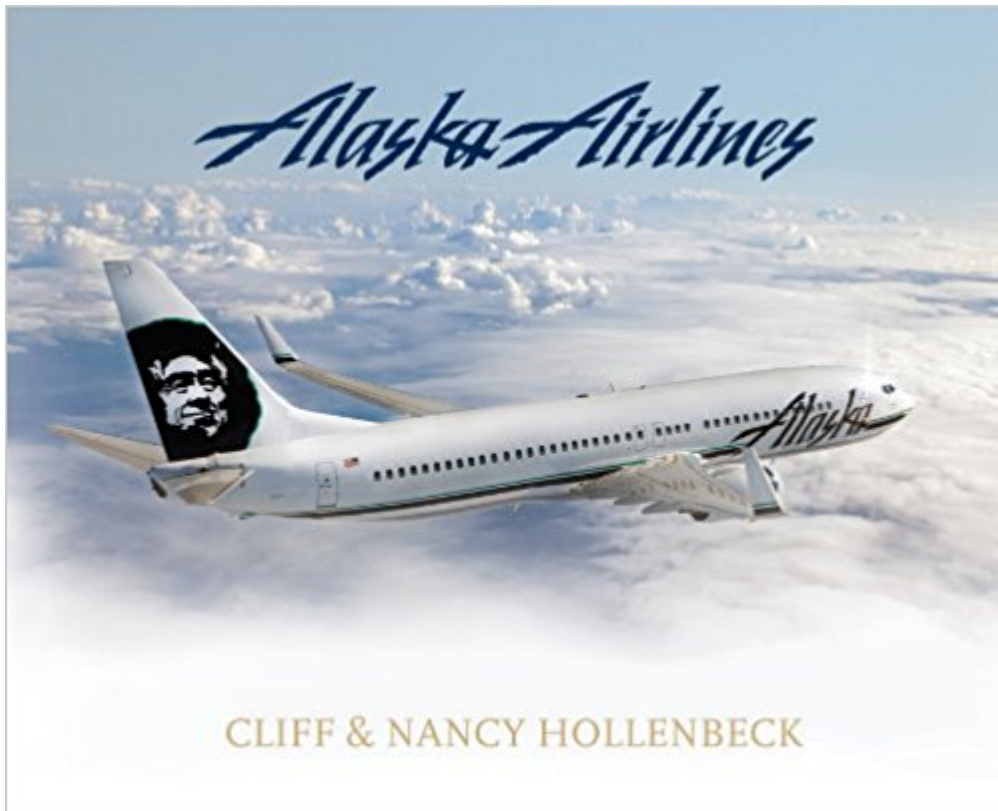

Well illustrated throughout, there are countless rare photos and images of the aircraft, people, and memorabilia from the early days of Alaska's ancestry through the jet age, post-deregulation expansion and Horizon Air. Informative text and impressive graphics make this THE book to have for anyone interested in the heritage of Alaska Airlines.
