Autumn's Display is a light, happy read that centers on a woman's walk through a park on a beautiful autumn day. The reader will discover charming sights throughout the book. The sole character of the story (an adult woman) strolls along and spies not only beautiful leaves, but also a young girl with a charming sense of humor, a lovely Scarlet Tanager bird, a charming Red Squirrel and an endearing Beagle puppy.
