

He includes his latest translations of not only the Gospel of Thomas, the Gospel of Philip, the Gospel of Mary, but other texts such as the Secret Book of John, which some scholars regard as the second part of the New Testament Gospel of John. The material is largely from the discovery at Nag Hammadi, freshly translated and introduced, but also includes texts found elsewhere. The texts, especially taken together, present an image of Jesus as the ultimate wisdom teacher, a kind of mysterious Jewish Zen master, who scandalized listeners by his radical egalitarianism (regarding women, slaves, the poor, the marginalized as of equal status, or more, with establishment male believers) and his insistence on living the message, spiritual experience, vs. outer observance only. o For those wanting to learn more after reading The Da Vinci Code. This book provides the definitive next book for those looking for expert presentation of the alternative Gnostic stream of Christianity, in which there is no talk of crucifixion and Mary Magdalene is presented as the disciple that Jesus loved best. Marvin Meyer is one of the foremost scholars on early Christianity and texts about Jesus outside the New Testament. He is Griset Professor of Bible and Christian Studies at Chapman University in Orange, California. Among his recent books are The Gospel of Judas, The Gnostic Gospels of Jesus, The Gospels of Mary, The Gospel of Thomas, and The Nag Hammadi Scriptures.

Marvin W. Meyer's The Gnostic Gospels of Jesus takes up twelve of the Nag Hammadi scrolls and a few other sources; for example, the Gospel of Thomas, the Gospel of Mary, and the Gospel of Philip. Each is treated to an introduction, of course, in English. This is all very satisfactory and interesting, but why not go for the WHOLE of the Nag Hammadi scrolls?--as edited by James M. Robinson, The Nag Hammadi Library in English, 1990, Harper, revised edition. Approximately FORTY scholars contributed to that particular book which also has introductory material and takes up more than forty gospels, acts, teachings, apocalypses, testimonies and fragments. To choose Meyer or Robinson might involve how much time you have to assign to your reading activities on this subject. Myself, I'd go with Robinson (in which you can pick and choose) rather than Meyer who has already chosen to concentrate on a dozen texts.

This book reveals that the Christian church was not an all-agreeing, lock-step entity at its inception. This book contributes to the reader's understanding of the socio-political and the religious environment that produced a variety of beginnings of Christianity. Also, the book functions as a catalyst for change in the way the reader perceives the canonized, Holy Bible. This book answers the why and the how the Bible includes what it includes. The why and the how as to the rejection, suppression, and the attempts at the destruction of the gnostic books are also given.

For those who are already familiar with these texts, I highly recommend Meyer's other book: "The Nag Hammadi Scriptures."
