

This is an interesting collection of photographs taken by 5 different Bangkok residents --- both locals and expats. Overall, the photography isn't all top-notch professional quality or shots that you would call amazing. That said, there are many cool pics scattered throughout the book, and the thing I like most is that it gives you a very interesting, and accurate, feel for what Bangkok really looks like. In other words, instead of temples, bars, and typical tourist places, the focus here is on the neighborhoods --- and the locals living there --- where these photographers live and work and shop and eat. Very nice idea. My only real complaint with this book is that there is very little text to accompany the photos. It would have nice to read some descriptions about the people and places that are pictured. There is also a companion "Lost & Found" book about Hong Kong by the same publisher that is worth getting.
