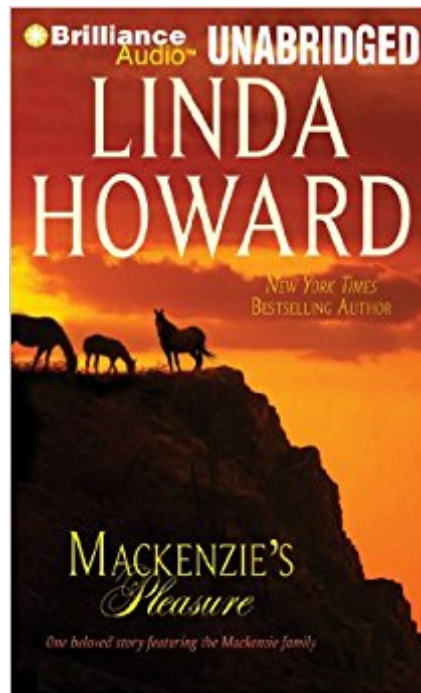

Linda Howard is the award-winning author of many New York Times bestsellers, including Drop Dead Gorgeous, Cover of Night, Killing Time, To Die For, Kiss Me While I Sleep, Cry No More, Dying to Please, Open Season, Mr. Perfect, All the Queen's Men, Now You See Her, Kill and Tell, and Son of the Morning. She lives in Alabama with her husband and two golden retrievers.

This book is the third in the beloved Mackenzie family series, written back in the 1990s and originally published by Silhouette. From the date (1996) and the publisher, a reader can safely predict the following:- the hero (Zane Mackenzie, formidable Navy SEAL) and heroine (Barrie Lovejoy, daughter of an ambassador but currently a victim of a kidnap) will fall for each other at first sight.- Zane will single-handedly rescue this damsel in distress from her plight- Barrie will instantly grant her favors to her hero- there will be more perils in store for both of them, but all obstacles will be overcome- there will be more intimate encounters between them- a happy-ever-after is

guaranteed, despite the occasional suspenseful scene. This book in many ways is typical of that era in the Romance genre, but is still enjoyable to read (or re-read) today. Any fan of Linda Howard will certainly be familiar with the Mackenzies and appreciate this entry. It is also a stand-alone, so you don't need to read Mackenzie's Mountain (the first book) or Mackenzie's Mission (the second) in order to find pleasure in Mackenzie's Pleasure. If you try this and like it, be on the lookout for the novella Mackenzie's Magic and the final volume in the series, A Game of Chance.

Mackenzie's Pleasure is a really good book to read. It has the feel of a white knight rescuing the damsel in distress and ends with the same feeling. I have re-read it more than a few times. Really good one by Linda Howard.

The book was great just as I remembered it. The 2nd story I haven't read as of yet. But the family story of the Mackenzies is a favorite and one I was missing in my personal library. I love getting old publications in great condition at half the price!

I bought this book because it was by Linda Howard, whom I enjoy in her current novels, but this one was awful. As soon as the main character (SPOILER ALERT) was aroused by the kidnap victim whom he found lying naked, bound and brutalized, I knew I was in trouble. I realize romance novels have changed in the years since this book was written, but still ... The only bright spot was the family of the main character, the MacKenzie clan. I think I'd like to know them. The Beverly Barton story wasn't better. This story was cliched to the extreme (single woman won't tell the father of her child that he IS the father of the child for some ridiculous reason) and the deception goes on and on and on well past when a reasonable person would give up on the lie. I was very disappointed.

I bought this to replace my wife's very dog-eared and falling apart original paperback copy. Finding it in larger print was even better. I'm not a reader of romance novels myself but my wife was ecstatic and has loved this book since it came out.

Love Linda Howard. Love the Mackenzie's. Wish there were more stories about the rest of the brothers.
