I'm studying for my RHIT exam and I must say this book is very helpful for me trying to understand the concepts in each domain for the test since I'm still in the process of using I cannot give a full review but I do recommend it for those studying for their RHIT or RHIA. I purchased this book NEW. It was well written with collaboration from other parties. The CD proved unneccesary, because the items on the CD were the same as the quizes in the book. My teacher ended up not using the quizes in the book, nor did she use the quizes on the CD due to the book having the answers in the back. She used alternate quizes that did not have the answers in the back of the book. Having the answers in the back of the book only allows for students to easily cheat.

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
