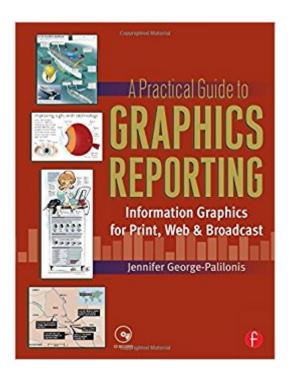

This book is actually more suited for beginners although experts might learn a few things too. It covers all the aspect of creating graphics for news reporting, on how to effectively tell a story on its own or complement the news. There are lessons on using multimedia graphics, doing research, understanding ethics, designing information graphics, creating maps and tables, analyzing statistics. There are numerous case studies and interviews included to relate back to the real world. The interviews are really useful. There's nothing like learning from the pros. If you like this book, you should also check out the rare Malofiej series of infographics books. They all contain interviews and tons of infographics examples. (Check out my profile for other books I've reviewed.)

Confused about how to conceptualize and execute information graphics? For journalists and graphic artists alike, this book is an invaluable resource for how to bring the two crafts together. The author takes care to provide real world examples that are clear and to-the-point and illustrate the topics at hand. This is an invaluable resource for small and medium-sized newsrooms in particular, as well as classrooms or individuals wanting to brush up on the state of the art of news graphics presentation.

This book is clean, simple, easy to understand. It's full of examples from daily graphics to large-scale graphics media thrive on.
