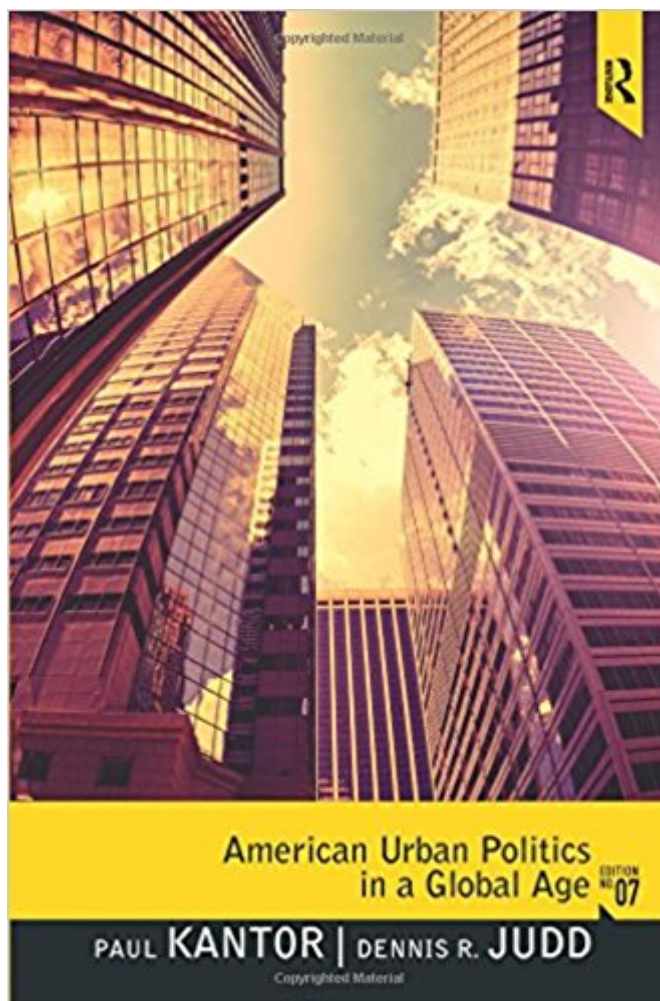

The book was used for a class and it had all the necessary material, but it did not have a source index. The book was not very useful as a text book or for looking up reference material. The bottom line is the book is not suited for a class text, but is well written for personal information.
