

The 70,000 Seychellois are a fusion of three continents - Africa, Asia, and Europe - speaking Creole, French, and English, who live on twenty-one islands. The other ninety-four isles - among them the only oceanic islands in the world made of granitic rock - remain uninhabited gardens of delight awaiting exploration. On these tropic, treasure isles, set in a turquoise sea against a backdrop of magnificent mountains, lush with palms and tropical vegetation, the echoes of life's beginnings can still be heard. Now their beauty, and the magic of their many unique creatures and plants are captured in the superb color photography of Mohamed Amin and Duncan Willetts with a memorable text by Adrian Skerrett.
