

His interest in numismatics stretches back to childhood and has lead him to be a part of the production of more than 100 price guides, many of them award winning.

Many updates from the previous edition. while as a whole, catalog "prices" are not highly accurate, this book serves as an excellent guide for collectors and for my own uses, help me to locate coins from my "topical collection" that otherwise I would not be aware of. I have recently been invited to edit and supplement a book on a particular aspect of topical collecting, and this book has proven invaluable in locating KM or Y numbers, get a rough retail value, mintage statistics, weights, composition and sizes...I recommend this book to anyone who collects world coins.
