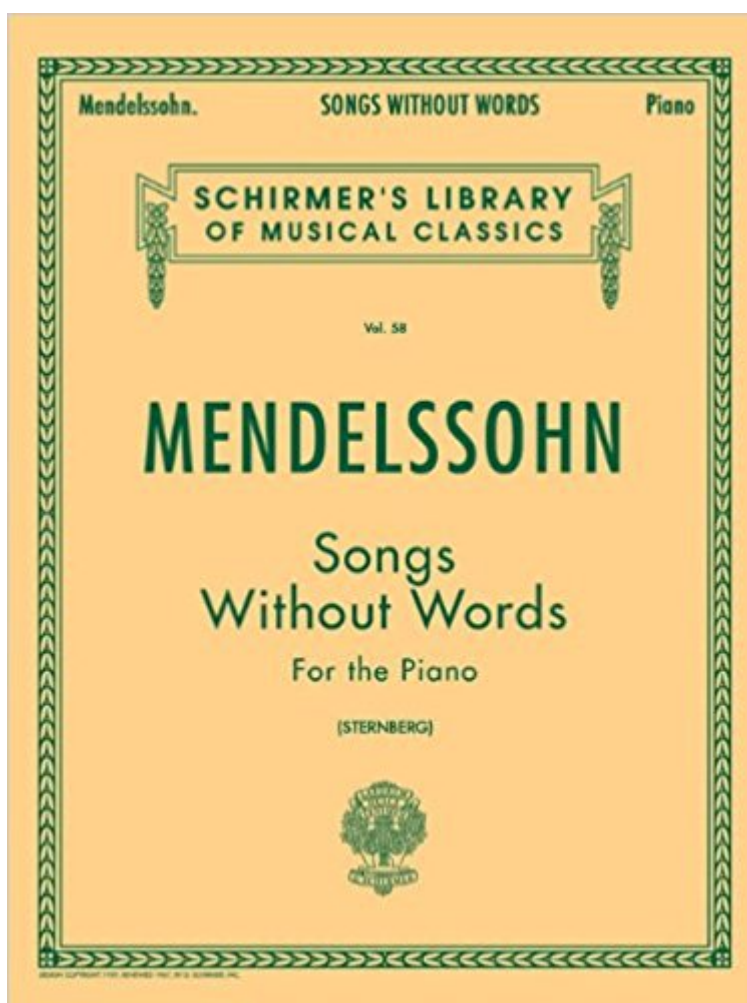

Schirmer collections offer excellent, reasonably-priced, editions of classical music and this selection of Mendelssohn's fine Lieder Ohne Woerter includes many of the most popular pieces written for the piano. Many are playable by intermediate pianists, with the rest being more advanced, but all are wonderful. I recommend this book to all pianists.

What charming pieces--without words no less--but surely as descriptive as a novel. Each one is a whiff of emotion. Melody, harmony, form unfold with the freedom of romantic expression so typical of the late romantic period (1850-1900). The level of technical difficulty varies from demanding to moderately easy. Some selections make for a delightful offertory in churches that appreciate and court the "classical" approach to music appreciation.
