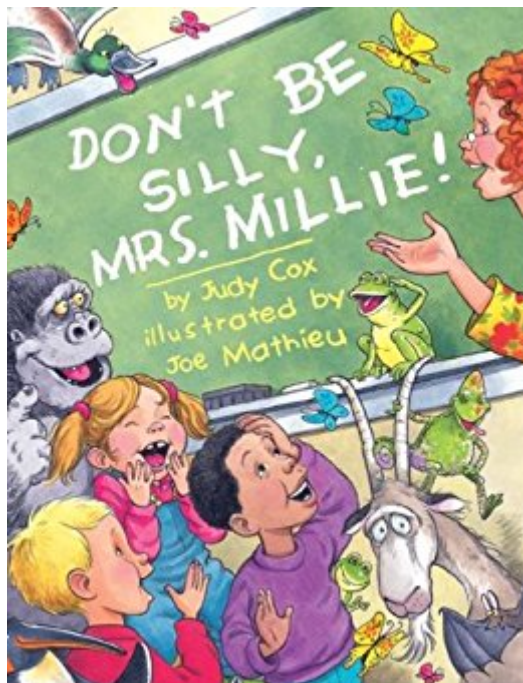

But this one, I would probably prefer to have in the printed version.
